Water Mission Delivers Safe Water to Haiti Hurricane Victims *Working with national Haitian government to limit cholera outbreak*

N Charleston, SC – October 12, 2016 – Water Mission, a nonprofit Christian engineering organization based in North Charleston, is deploying 10 safe water treatment systems and other equipment from its Port-au-Prince, Haiti office to the southwestern regions of the country in response to Hurricane Matthew. Water Mission's permanent staff in Haiti are co-developing a national response with the Haitian government and UNICEF Haiti to provide access to flowing safe water in communities as quickly as possible in order to restore basic needs and prevent the spread of cholera.

Each safe water treatment system is capable of serving up to 4,000 people per day in disaster situations.

Later this week, Water Mission will ship 10 additional safe water treatment systems from its North Charleston headquarters to Haiti with capacity to provide safe water for up to 40,000 people. In addition, 900 Kohler Clarity water treatment units for household use will also be sent from inventory in North Charleston.
