- Synthesizing information on MEL frameworks from Water Mission partners, friends, and sector experts
- Developing a standard operating procedure for MEL at Water Mission
- Creating appealing presentations and visuals to share with internal and external audiences
- Creating a desk report of work completed during internship
- Other research-related duties as assigned
