This position is responsible for managing Water Mission's digital asset management system (Libris), photographing all headquarter photography needs, and assisting in the production of Water Mission videos.

- Responsible for photographing staff headshots, volunteers, tour groups, events, etc.
- Responsible for managing the tagging of images in Libris
- Assist with video production including script writing, filming, post production, etc.
