**1. How many people around the world lack access to clean, safe water?**

Kids miss school because they spend so much time collecting water for their families. Often, that water is unsafe and makes them too sick to go to school.

**3. When Water Mission's founders, George and Molly Greene, visited Honduras following Hurricane Mitch, they found a river that people called "The River of Death." Why do you think they called it that?**

Many people who drank from the river that served as a water source got sick because it was so contaminated. It was the color of chocolate milk. The river contained toxins and bacteria.

**4. How did George and Molly Greene encourage residents to trust that the treated water was safe to drink?**

The Greenes drank the treated water themselves to demonstrate that it was safe.

**5. When does Water Mission work to help people?**

Water Mission provides safe water for in communities that don't have water or to those suffering as a result of a disaster or emergency situation.
