Who is Water Mission?

Water Mission is a Christian engineering nonprofit that builds sustainable safe water solutions for people in developing countries, refugee camps, and disaster areas. Since 2001, Water Mission has served more than 8 million people in 60 countries, sharing safe water and the message of God's love. Working at Water Mission is as much a calling as it is a career, and we are searching for people with the courage, passion, and drive to help us change the world.

What is the opportunity?

The Living Water Program intern will work closely with the Water Mission Living Water Manager to assist in providing direction, guidance, and encouragement for the Living Water Program in each country where Water Mission is serving. The Living Water intern will focus their calling to full-time ministry on encouraging Water Mission staff and national staff to be active in sharing their faith, the "Living Water" as they serve around the world. The Living Water intern will also support the Living Water Manager in providing additional support for national Living Water staff as they implement the Living Water program in communities across their countries.

The scope of this internship may include:

- Communicate with international Living Water staff around the world on a regular basis.
- Coordinate efforts to gather key data from Living Water projects and process that data to improve the effectiveness of the Living Water Program.
- Support Living Water Strategy as it is implemented in key communities by Water Mission Staff
- Work with Living Water Manager and Living Water staff to develop more "culturally connected" Church and Community Mobilization Program stories and examples to improve the integration of its principles into the life of the attendees.
- Work with the Living Water Manager to continue to build a robust Messenger and LightStream resource library for all country offices.
- Use SharePoint to promote Living Water updates and victories to Water Mission staff, partners, and prayer partners.

What is required?

- Confident leading towards full-time ministry, but not certain of specifics
- Will be a rising Junior, Senior, or seminary/grad student.
- The ability to commit to 15-25 hours per week, depending upon availability.
- Water Mission is based in Charleston, SC, but this position is open to a remote candidate anywhere in the U.S.
- Spanish or Swahili language ability is a plus.
- Must be a self-starter and self-motivated.
- International travel experience preferred.
- Ability to travel internationally if budget/time allows. Would require a passport with 6 months or more and vaccine records. *(Living Water Manager will advocate for this on a case by case basis.)*
